

HOW TO USE THE SCHEDULE OF COURSES

You need to get a copy of the **Schedule of Courses** every semester you attend the University of Massachusetts Dartmouth because each semester the course offerings, faculty assignments, schedule numbers and classrooms change. One of the most helpful items in the **Schedule** is the Calendar on page II which contains important deadlines and dates for academic procedures. The **Schedule** also contains an information section, the list of courses offered, a service directory and faculty directory.



The class hours are listed in the **Schedule of Courses** using a 12 hour clock.
