

## Interpretation of Math Placement Test Scores for Nursing Majors

In order to understand your Math placement scores and placement into your first semester math course, please follow instructions below.

1. If your algebra placement score (ALGPL) is **72** or higher you place into the required first year courses: MTH 104 Statistics or MTH 120 Quantitative Reasoning and Chemistry 101.
2. If your algebra placement score (ALGPL) score is **less than 72** you will be placed in a review math course, MTH 100 (which receives no college credit) and do not qualify to enroll in the required Chemistry 101 in the fall. Successful completion of CHM 101 and 102 is necessary for progression to the sophomore year. We strongly recommend that you make arrangements to take a refresher course in mathematics, either in basic algebra (MTH100) or possibly an entry level college math course over the summer. UMassD offers these courses through the Division of Professional and Continuing Education (<http://www.umassd.edu/pce/> or 508-990-1160). There are similar courses offered at various other schools. If you successfully complete either a review course or an entry level course during the summer, you will be able to enroll in CHM 101 in the fall.
