

# GENERAL BIOLOGY ADVISING TRACK:

Students who have not yet decided on a career or who would like a broad-based education in Biology may select this advising track.

Students pursuing a BS degree in Biology take two years of required core courses in biology, chemistry, math, and physics. Additionally, 18 credits in advanced biology courses (300-400) level are required for graduation.
