



## MINOR IN EDUCATION

### ADMISSIONS PROCESS

- Students will be considered after completion of 60 credits.
- Students will have at least a 2.75 overall GPA and a 3.00 GPA in their major. This standard is appropriate in that these students will be taking three graduate-level courses for the minor. Transfer students may use the GPA in their Major from their prior institution.

**Recommended:** For students interested in the Education Minor it is recommended that they take the MTEL (01) Communication & Literacy test as soon as possible during their sophomore or junior year.

### COURSES FOR MINOR IN ELEMENTARY EDUCATION

- EDU 201 Philosophy of Education
- EDU 207 Teaching as a Profession
- PSY 201 Child Psychology (Prerequisite: PSY 101)

**Note:** Before proceeding to EDU 500-level courses, students must apply and be admitted to the Education Minor meeting the GPA requirements outlined in the Admissions Process.

- EDU 520 Teaching Reading in Elementary School (Prerequisite: EDU 207)
- EDU 527 Integrated Instructional Planning K-12 (Prerequisite: EDU 207)
- EDU 547 Managing Inclusive Classrooms (Prerequisite: EDU 207)

Additional courses that lead to licensure for Elementary Education include the following courses and are suggested as electives:

- EDU 503 Science for Elementary Teachers (Prerequisites: EDU 207, 527) (EDU 527 may be taken concurrently)
- EDU 508 Math for Elementary Teachers (Prerequisites: EDU 207, 527) (EDU 527 may be taken concurrently)
- EDU 504 Language Arts (Prerequisites: EDU 207, 527) (EDU 527 may be taken concurrently)
