

Humanities Concentration: PORTUGUESE STUDIES

Students will learn to communicate in Portuguese and will study literature and the historical and cultural realities of the Portuguese-speaking world.

LAR students must choose *one* of the two options in the Portuguese Concentration.

Literary and Cultural Studies Option Advising Checklist

One course from this list 3 credits

- POR 214: Portuguese Literature in Translation
- POR 215: Brazilian Literature in Translation
- POR 216: Lusophone African Literature in Translation
- POR 217: Portuguese-American Literature
- POR 270: Music and Cinema of Brazil

Three required courses as follows:

- POR 301: Portuguese Composition and Conversation I 3 credits
- POR 302: Portuguese Composition and Conversation II 3 credits
- POR 310: Introduction to Literary and Cultural Analysis 3 credits

One course from this list 3 credits

- POR 331: Introduction to Portuguese Literature I
- POR 332: Introduction to Portuguese Literature II
- POR 333: Introduction to Brazilian Literature I
- POR 334: Introduction to Brazilian Literature II
- POR 335: Introduction to Lusophone African Literatures

Note: POR 302 is a pre-requisite for the 300-level literature courses.

Language and Linguistics Option Advising Checklist

Three required courses as follows:

- POR 301: Portuguese Composition and Conversation I 3 credits
- POR 302: Portuguese Composition and Conversation II 3 credits
- POR 321: Introduction to Portuguese Linguistics 3 credits

Two courses from this list: 6 credits

- POR 303: Comparative Structures of English and Portuguese
- POR 305: Introduction to Translation and Business Portuguese I
- POR 306: Introduction to Translation and Business Portuguese II

Note: POR 302 is a pre-requisite for the 300-level electives.
