

## Requirements to Graduate for Psychology Majors

To graduate as a Psychology major you must complete the following.

\_\_\_ General Education Requirements

\_\_\_ College of Arts and Sciences Requirements

\_\_\_ Psychology Requirements—note all courses for the major must be passed with C- or better

\_\_\_ 120 credits, at least 45 of which must be taken at UMASS Dartmouth

\_\_\_ 30 of the 120 credits must be upper level (300 or 400)

\_\_\_ Minimum GPA for Psychology (2.00 after 20 credits; 2.75 after 50 credits)
