Change of Major Policy

Admission to any of the majors in the Charlton College of Business is a competitive process. Students will be admitted to the college if they meet one of the following two criteria:

- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher after completing 24 credit hours at UMass Dartmouth;
- or
- Be in good academic standing with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 AND have a GPA of 2.7 or higher in the following four (4) courses*: (effective 5/15/2008)

ACT 211 (Principles of Accounting I)

MTH 103 (Finite Math)

POM 212 (Basic Statistics) (MTH 103 is the prerequisite for this course)

ECO 231 (Principles of Microeconomics)

*These courses must be taken at UMD. No substitute courses will be accepted, nor will transfer courses be allowed.

Business Courses for Non-Business Majors and Minors

Non-Business majors are prohibited from taking any courses in the Charlton College of Business without permission from the Office of the Dean of the Charlton College of Business.

Dual Major Policy

All students who select a dual major within the College of Business must complete a minimum of 24 credit hours for the second major. This will bring the graduation requirements to at least 144 credit hours for dual majors.
