

Arts Management Tenured Track Professor Ad for Chronicle on Higher Ed:

Arts Management Program, Assistant Professor: The College of Charleston School of the Arts, Arts Management Program invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor position, beginning Fall 2008. Required qualifications include Masters degree in Arts Management, Arts Administration, Cultural Policy or related field with additional graduate work toward PhD in related field, preferred. Qualifications also include demonstrated interest, training or experience in the arts and arts management; strong teaching and research credentials; practical experience in arts management; and a commitment to professional service to the field.

Primary duties include teaching *Introduction to Arts Management*, *Arts Financial Management*, supervising arts management internships in the undergraduate arts management program and teaching occasional courses in the Masters of Public Administration (MPA) Program's arts management concentration. The program includes approximately 140 undergraduate majors and eight MPA students concentrating in arts management.

Qualified applicants should submit: 1) letter of interest including evidence of teaching experience, research areas and community service; 2) curriculum vitae; 3) official transcripts; and 4) three letters of recommendation.
