Kennesaw State University is now accepting applications for a twelve-month, tenure-track position as Department Chair in the Department of Visual Arts, beginning summer 2008.

In addition to two on-campus galleries, Phase 1 of the new KSU museum opened in October 2007. The Atlanta area has six museums and more than 130 active galleries.

RESPONSIBILITIES/QUALIFICATIONS:

The successful candidate will hold a Ph.D. in Art Education or Art History or a M.F.A. in studio and a record of effective teaching, scholarly research and/or creative work. Strong oral, written, and interpersonal communication skills and previous experience as an arts department chair or director are required. The successful candidate will have knowledge of national accreditation (SACS, NASAD, NCATE), an understanding of curricular issues, budgetary management skills, technology skills, and long-range planning abilities. KSU has established a notable record for the inclusion of minorities and women in its educational mission and strongly encourages applications in both groups. The successful candidate will bring enthusiastic leadership to a rapidly growing department and a commitment to collegiality and diversity.
