POSITION DESCRIPTION: Full-time, tenure-track, Assistant/Associate Professor beginning August 2008. Ability to teach primary area of expertise and 3-D design. Knowledge of and capabilities in traditional processes with a focus on contemporary applications highly desirable. Programmatic interests include metal casting, fabrication, installation, and cross-disciplinary approaches to media. Ability to operate and maintain all equipment necessary to teach in the sculpture studio.

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

- Teaching at all levels of undergraduate sculpture
- Student advising
- Ongoing professional development
- Taking an active role in departmental service

FACILITIES: The sculpture studio is a large open space of about 4000 square feet with full facilities for wood, plastics and metal fabrication. Metal casting facilities have been used at the adjacent School of Engineering and at Sloss Furnaces.
