

The University of Mississippi Department of Art invites applications for a full-time, non-tenure-track position in graphic design at the rank of Instructor for the Fall 2008 semester, beginning August 21, 2008. MFA required by date of appointment.

The applicant must have experience teaching in a Macintosh computer lab and have experience with web-based applications. The lab contains 4 G5 Power Macintosh computers, 10 iMacs with G5 processors, 6 G4 Power Macintosh computers, and 1 Dell Power PC for testing websites.

Responsibilities include teaching 18 contact hours per week, with courses in vector imaging, typography, and web design for undergraduate and graduate students. Other responsibilities include supervising student lab monitors and maintaining computer graphics lab facilities.
