

## Violation of F-1 Visa Status—Questions and Answers

### How is it possible to lose F-1 status?

You can lose your F-1 status by doing any of the following:

- Failing to maintain full-time registration (12 cr. undergraduates and law school students, 9 cr. graduate students) every semester; no more than **one on-line course** is allowed each semester; if you have only one course to complete your program, it **cannot** be an on-line course
- Failing to obtain official authorization from ISSC for **any** changes in your enrollment
- Failing to earn passing grades in your courses (average of C (2.00 GPA) or better for undergraduates and law students; B or better *in each course* for graduate students);
- Failing to make sufficient academic progress towards completing your program or degree
- Failing to keep your passport valid
- Failing to keep your I-20 paperwork valid; this means having your I-20 end date in the future so that it covers either a program of study in which you are currently enrolled or approved Post-Completion Optional Practical Training (OPT)
- Failing to accept **only** authorized employment, and for a maximum of 20 hours a week while enrolled in classes
- Failing to report **immediately** if you change your address – or within 10 days at the **latest** – even in the summer
- Failing to report **immediately** if you change your name
- Receiving any official dismissal from the University
- Any other circumstances that may apply; these will be reviewed and decided on a case-by-case basis

<p><b>Please Note:</b> Receiving a dismissal from the University for <b>any</b> reason may make you ineligible for reinstatement. Please consult with the ISSC <i>before</i> proceeding.</p>

### What are the consequences of being out of status?

Students who are out of status are not eligible for any of the benefits of F-1 status, including permission to work or eligibility for practical training. You no longer have a legal status to stay in the U.S., which can cause a variety of risks and issues for you.

### How can I get back into valid F-1 status?

You may apply for reinstatement using the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) ELIS system. Complete the [Reinstatement Application](#) and meet with an ISSC advisor.

### How long will the USCIS take to adjudicate my reinstatement request?

Currently there is no way to know.

### Am I allowed to work while my application is being processed in ELIS?

No. Employment is a benefit of valid F-1 visa status.
