## **MTEL Communication and Literacy Skills - Test #01 (10 hours) Preparing for the Massachusetts Test for Teacher Licensure**

“The Communication and Literacy Skills test consists of two subtests: reading and writing. The reading subtest contains multiple-choice items and word meaning (vocabulary) items. The writing subtest contains four sections: written summary, written composition, grammar and usage, and written mechanics. Areas tested include the comprehension and analysis of readings; development of ideas in essay form on specific topics; outlining and summarizing; interpretation of tables and graphs; and mastery of vocabulary, grammar, and mechanics.” 2007–2008 MTEL Registration Bulletin
