**ELIGIBILITY for
DEFERRED TUITION & FEES**

Full-Time Financial Aid Students: Deferments may be granted to matriculating students only (students who have been accepted into a degree program) and have evidence of having applied for financial aid. PCE students must have a degree application on file and have applied for financial aid.

Employer Sponsored: Payment may be deferred until the end of the semester for students eligible for employer sponsored reimbursement. The student must present a letter from the employer at the time of registration. Payments must be received by the University within 30 days of grades being posted. Student is responsible for payment if they fail to meet the grade requirement by the employer.

**REGULATIONS for
DEFERRED TUITION & FEES**

1. The financial obligations for this registration must be paid, whether or not you attend classes, unless an official withdrawal form is completed by you prior to the first (1) class meeting.
2. After classes have begun, if you complete an official withdrawal form before the fourth (4) class meeting, 50% of the tuition only is reimbursed and a grade of W is entered on your transcript.
3. If no withdrawal form is completed by you and any grade is awarded at the end of the term, including a W, F or I, 100% of tuition and fees are due.
4. Before you receive a grade report or a transcript, or register for the following term at the University of Massachusetts Dartmouth, your entire balance due must be paid.

University policy requires the withholding of all credits, educational services, issuance of transcripts, and certifications of academic records from any person whose financial obligations to the University (including delinquent student accounts, deferred balances, and liability for damage) are due and/or unpaid. If any overdue obligation is referred either to the University Collection Department or to an outside agency or attorney for collection efforts and/or legal suit, the debt is increased to cover all reasonable costs of collection, including collection agency, attorneys' fees, and court costs. By registering for any class in the University, each student accepts and agrees to be bound by the foregoing University policy as applied to any preexisting or future obligation to the University.

In the event that third party payments or financial aid are not received by UMass Dartmouth Professional & Continuing Education; students retain responsibility for payment of tuition and fees.
