

## Advanced Placement (AP) Examinations

### AP Examinations --- Catalogue Policies

Advanced Placement and college credit are awarded to entering freshmen students presenting Advanced Placement Examination grades of three or higher (four for credit in Psychology) in most AP fields. AP courses taught in high schools are college-level courses and the students' mastery of the content is validated by the AP Examination series administered by the College Board. Such course credits may be used to satisfy degree requirements.
