APPLICATION TO JOIN THE UNIVERSITY HONORS PROGRAM • FALL 2009

This application is for students **who have already begun their studies at UMass Dartmouth** and who wish to apply to join the University Honors Program on the basis of their UMD GPA at the end of the Fall 2009 semester. **Admission is restricted to students who will have earned 40 OR FEWER university credits by the end of the semester**, including transfer credits, AP test credits, and Fall 2009 courses in progress. **Admission decisions will be made on the basis of UMD grades only.** High school grades, SAT scores, and high school honors courses will not be considered.

Space in the Honors Program is extremely limited, so we will be able to accept only those applicants with the highest UMD GPAs. Decisions will be made after Fall 2009 final grades are posted in late December. Notification will be by email.

If accepted, you must come into compliance with the Honors Program requirements as quickly as possible. These requirements are posted on the Honors Program webpage (<http://www.umassd.edu/specialprograms/honors/welcome.cfm>). **At a minimum, successful applicants must add at least one Honors course to their Spring 2010 schedules.** You will be expected to be in full compliance with Honors Program requirements by the end of the Fall 2010 semester. If you fail to meet these requirements, you will be dismissed from the Honors Program.

The deadline for applications for admission on the basis of Fall 2009 grades is **3:00 PM on Tuesday, December 8.** Applications should be submitted to the Honors Center on the fourth floor of the University Library (Room 402, telephone 999-8820). Please note that the application requires approval by your academic advisor or department chair. Business majors, Liberal Arts majors, and undeclared students in the College of Arts & Sciences should seek approval at the Academic Advising Center on the first floor of the Administration Building. Incomplete applications will be rejected.
