Performers Biography:

Debashish represents the 7th generation in a family of musicians. He first learnt vocal from his parents and later on found the guitar to be his instrument. He studied and stayed with his teacher, the renowned Guitar Maestro Pandit Brij Bhooshan Kabra, for ten years. Apart from his memorable solos and collaboration with John McLaughlin, Zakir Hussain, Bob Brozman, Martin Spencer and many others Debashish has to his credit several music albums and the title music for the Hollywood movie "Life During War Time".
