Topic: Spirituality and its relevance in modern day life

Abstract: With the collapse of World com, Enron and such giant corporations ethics and morality have made their way into the operations jargon of modern companies. The current talk examines the concept of spirituality and tries to analyze if it has relevance to modern day life and whether it can play an active role to improve the socio economic environment.
