In Portugal, on the night of April 24, 1974 and into the early morning hours of the 25th, a Portuguese radio station aired a banned song: "Grândola". It could have just been an act of insubordination by a rebellious journalist, but in fact it was much more than that. It was a preplanned signal, triggering a military coup that was to change the face of the country, as well as the destiny of vast territories in Africa.
