

Getting Started with Microsoft Authenticator

To get started with Microsoft Authenticator, follow the steps below.


- 1. Log into your Microsoft account using your full UMass Dartmouth email and password.
- 2. In the "More information required" window, click **Next** to launch the enrollment wizard.



3. Follow the on-screen prompts to download and install the **Microsoft Authenticator app** on your phone. Already have Microsoft Authenticator installed on your phone? Skip to Step 6.



a. Click **Download now** to go to the download page. Scan the QR code to download the MS Authenticator app for your mobile device (Android or Apple only). If you cannot scan the QR code, click the corresponding "Get the app" button beneath the QR code that matches your device.



b. **Search the App Store or Google Play Store:** Alternatively, you can search for "Microsoft Authenticator" in the App Store or Google Play Store. Be sure to download the correct app (compare the app icon):






On your Mobile Device:

- 4. **Open the Microsoft Authenticator app**. If opening the Authenticator app for the first time, you will see a few notices:
 - a. If prompted, **Accept** Microsoft's privacy statement.
 - b. Turn on or off app usage data and select Continue.




Return to the browser:

5. Return to the web browser and click **Next** to continue the MFA setup.




6. Follow the on-screen prompts to continue setting up your UMassD account in the MS Authenticator app on your mobile device.




In the Authenticator app:


7. In the Authenticator app on your mobile device, select **Add Account** or click the **+ sign** if you already have accounts set up.




a. Select Work or school account




- b. If using the Authenticator app for the first time, you will see a few notices:
 - i. When prompted, Allow Authenticator access to your camera



ii. When prompted, **Allow** Authenticator to send you notifications




c. Select **Scan QR code** to activate the phone's camera.




Return to the Browser:

- 8. Pairing the App to your UMassD account:
 - a. Use your phone's camera or a QR Reader app to scan the QR code in the browser with MFA set up.




- b. If using a mobile device, click the link "Pair your account to the app by clicking this link". Your phone will open the Microsoft Authenticator app.

 Once you see your UMassD account listed, go back to your browser window.
- c. Click **Next** after you pair your account.
- 9. Verify your UMass Dartmouth account is connected to the Microsoft Authenticator app. Your phone will prompt you for authentication using the Microsoft Authenticator app.




Copy the unique number shown in the Authenticator browser window and enter it into the Authenticator app to confirm the connection.




In the Browser:

10. The Microsoft Authenticator window will confirm the account set up with a "Notification approved" message once the Microsoft Authenticator app verifies the connection. Click **Next** to continue.



11. Once your UMassD account is registered with the Microsoft Authenticator app, you will see a green message confirming the registration.



12. Click **Done** when finished.
