



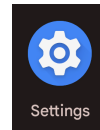
Forget a Wireless Network on Android

If you have trouble connecting to a wireless network, it can be helpful to remove the network from your preferred networks, and then attempt to reconnect.

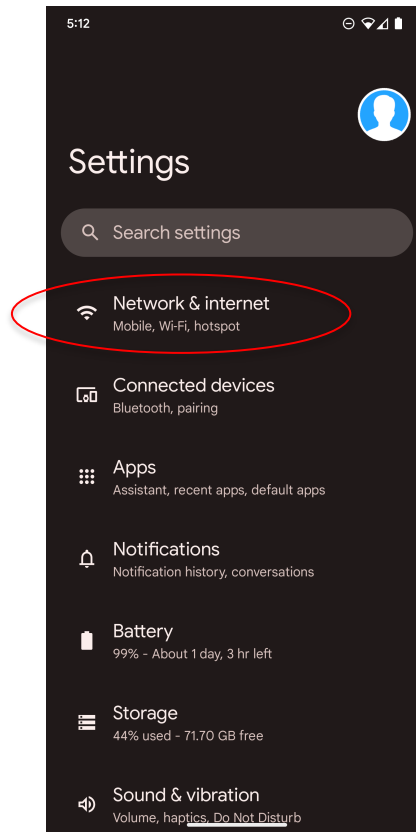
These instructions illustrate Android version 13. Your device may appear differently.

1. Open the **Settings** app on your home screen.

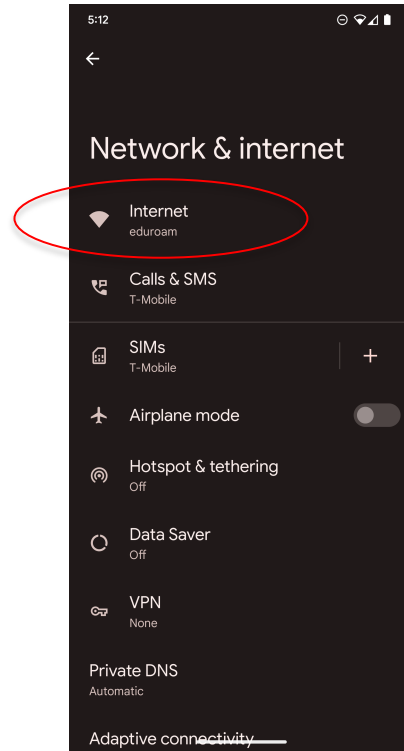


2. Tap **Network & internet**.



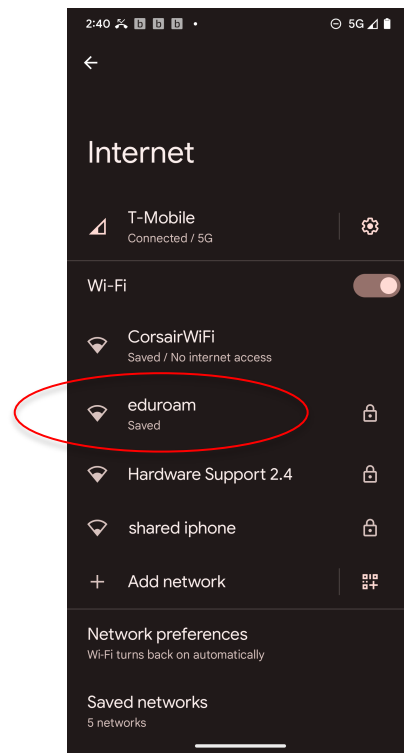


3. The Network settings are displayed.



Tap **Internet**.

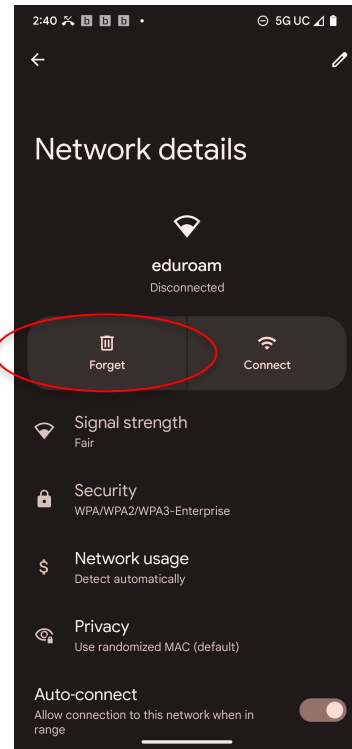
4. The Internet settings are displayed.
