


How to Connect to Eduroam on a Chromebook

- 1. Open up your Network menu by clicking on the WiFi symbol in the bottom left corner.
- 2. Select the Wi-Fi symbol as shown.



3. In the Network menu, choose eduroam.

NOTE: You can also click on the "i" symbol in the top right corner if you are asked to get the MAC Address of your device.
