**For students accepted into the Honors College for Fall 2020 or later, these students are required to:**

- maintain an overall university GPA of 3.2 or higher;
- complete a minimum of 24 credits of Honors course work with a grade of B or higher in each course, including the Honors 301 thesis preparation seminar in the junior year (see timeline below);
- complete an original thesis under faculty supervision, for which the student typically earns at least three credits; and make a public presentation of this work in an appropriate venue, such as a thesis defense, capstone presentation, or conference poster presentation.

60 total credits, or four semesters at UMassD, whichever comes first.	At least <b>twelve</b> Honors credits.
90 total credits, or six semesters at UMassD, whichever comes first.	At least <b>eighteen</b> Honors credits, including Honors 301, and submission of thesis project proposal.
120 total credits, or eight semesters at UMassD, whichever comes first.	All 24 credits with minimum GPA 3.2.

<sup>2</sup> For students entering the Honors College after completing EGR 111 (non-honors), you will take an additional honors elective to meet this requirement.

<sup>3</sup> Students who earn AP credits for ENL 101/102 should consult with their advisor for alternative courses.

<sup>4</sup> HON 301 will meet your University Studies 4B requirement, effective Fall 2021.

<sup>5</sup> Honors electives should be chosen from this list (in consultation with your advisor): CHM 151H; ENL 266H; University Studies 3AH or 3BH; BNG 255H; or CEN 400 level 'honored' course to provide technical depth on par with the cross-listed graduate course.
