CARNEY

The Carney project is focused on Carney Academy, a small inner-city elementary school in a neighboring town of New Bedford. It aims to educate the students by teaching them lessons using an interactive approach.

GOALS

- » Teach students about growing plants
- » Help students learn about entrepreneurial ideas
- » Implement a future plan for teachers to use to teach the kids to be ready for MCAS

ACHIEVEMENTS

- » Prepared lesson plans
- » Conducted pre-tests and post-tests to assess student knowledge
- » Assisted the students in preparing for the state fair
- » Brought in a local greenhouse owner to speak about entrepreneurship and growing plants



LIBRARY FOR LIBERIA

Library for Liberia is a book collection project that involves local universities and colleges with the goal of expanding the educational resources available in a new library in Liberia. We strive to improve the illiteracy rates in this country where educational resources were so badly damaged during 14 years of civil war. GOALS

- » Expand the project to empower the children who will utilize this new library
- » Build relations with local officials in Liberia
- » Bring in other groups to empower more individuals ACHIEVEMENTS
- » Collected over 1,000 books
- » Provided resources for 1,400 different grade level schools



GLOBAL IMPACT

This project is about bringing together the people of Santo Domingo, Jalapa, Guatemala and helping them build and develop a stronger community by teaching them entrepreneurship principles, providing first aid training, healthcare education, and consultation.

GOALS

- » Effectively empower the community through first aid training and business skills education
- » Improve the quality and standard of living ACHIEVEMENTS
- » Raised \$2,600 to visit Jalapa to teach business and health skills, \$3,322 invested in the project
- » Taught CPR, First Aid skills, Marketing, Planning and Entreprenuership workshops to 182 adults and distributed toothpaste and brushes to their children
- » Worked with the Guatemala Enactus teams to present the workshops

Hair Empowerment and Leadership Project (HELP) created awareness and helped empower men and women to embrace their natural hair through education. We informed them about the harmful effects of unnatural hair products. They learned that applying chemicals to one's hair could cause damage to one's hair folical, lead to hair loss, scalp irritation, and discoloration of hair. GOALS


