# 19-20 Joseph A. Bronstad Scholarship – Study Abroad in Hessen

- **Must be a sophomore, junior, or senior**
- **Preference given to students maintaining at least a 3.0 GPA**
- **Preference given to students who have completed German 101 and 102**
