

2021-2022 RECENT GRADUATE ALUMNI OUTCOMES AY 2022 NACE Data Collection of Graduate Alumni¹

METHODOLOGY

Approximately three months following the completion of their studies, 550 graduate level alumni who had earned their degrees during the 2021-2022 academic year (AY 2022) were asked to participate in the online Recent Graduate Survey (RGS) about their employment and educational activities since graduation (note: Law students were excluded because the Law School has specific standards for alumni follow-ups).

Overall, 209 graduate level alumni responded to the RGS (a response rate of 38.0%). In an effort to increase the knowledge rate of our graduating class, additional datamining was completed for those who did not respond to the RGS survey invitations. Efforts from the Career Center and the Office of Institutional Research and Assessment (OIRA) increased the knowledge rate of our graduating class to 77.8% (n=428) by obtaining additional information on 219² graduate level alumni. This brief details the principal findings from the RGS survey and datamining collection.

Key Findings:

- 94.1% of AY 2022 graduate level alumni were employed within three months after graduation.*
- 94.3% of AY 2022 graduate level alumni were employed or enrolled in further education within three months after graduation.*
- The full-time employment rate for AY 2022 graduate level alumni three months post-graduation was 90.4%.*
- Of all the AY 2022 graduate level alumni, 14.6%** were enrolled in another advanced certificate or degree following earning their graduate certificate or degree from UMassD.
- The average annual full-time gross salary for the AY 2022 graduate level alumni working full-time was \$83,322 (median: \$70,000).

EMPLOYMENT OUTCOMES: GRADUATE LEVEL ALUMNI

- 60.3% of those who were employed were working in Massachusetts.
- 14.1% of those employed were working in another New England state (RI, CT, NH, VT, ME) with another 24.5% working outside New England but in the U.S. or its territories. The other 1.1% were working in a country outside of the U.S. or its territories.
- 5.9%* of AY 2022 graduate level alumni were not employed three months after graduation and were seeking employment. Furthermore, 2.9% were unemployed and were not seeking employment.
 - The most frequent occupational groups by AY 2022 graduate level alumni who were employed:
 - 1. Education, Training, and Library Occupations (18.5%)
 - 2. Business and Financial Operations Occupations (15.3%)
 - 3. Computer and Mathematical Occupations (10.9%)
 - 4. Architecture and Engineering Occupations (10.1%)
 - 5. Healthcare Practitioners & Technical Occupations (6.8%)

EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES: GRADUATE LEVEL ALUMNI

- Of all the AY 2022 graduate level alumni, 14.6%** were currently enrolled in further education.
- More than half (65.7%) of those engaged in further education were pursuing some type
 of advanced degree (e.g., Ph.D. or Ed.D., M.D. or D.O., J.D.) or graduate certificate.
 34.3% were pursuing another graduate level degree (i.e., MBA, MS, MA, or other Master's degree).
- Of those AY 2022 graduate level alumni, 48.4% were pursuing their advanced degree at UMass Dartmouth and another 6.5% were enrolled at UMass School of Law.
