

2020-2021 RECENT UNDERGRADUATE ALUMNI OUTCOMES

AY 2021 NACE Data Collection of Undergraduate Alumni

METHODOLOGY

Approximately six months following the completion of their studies, 1,297 undergraduate alumni who had earned their degrees during the 2020-2021 academic year (AY 2021) were asked to participate in the online Recent Graduate Survey (RGS) about their employment and educational activities since graduation.

Overall, 278 undergraduate alumni responded to the RGS (a response rate of 21.4%). In an effort to increase the knowledge rate of our graduating class, additional datamining was completed for those who did not respond to the RGS survey invitations. Efforts from the Career Center and the Office of Institutional Research and Assessment (OIRA) increased the knowledge rate of our graduating class to 48.7% (n=631) with obtaining additional information on 353 undergraduate alumni. This brief details the principal findings from the RGS survey and datamining collection.

Key Findings:

- 96.7% of AY 2021 undergraduate alumni were employed OR enrolled in further education within six months after graduation.*
- The full-time employment rate for AY 2021 undergraduate alumni six months post-graduation was 81.2%.*
- 100.0% of undergraduate alumni from the College of Nursing and Health Sciences were employed six months post-graduation with a full-time employment rate of 92.6%.
- The College of Engineering revealed 97.6% of undergraduate alumni were employed six months post-graduation with the Charlton College of Business comparable at 97.1% employed six months post-graduation.
- Of all the AY 2021 undergraduate alumni, 31.6%** are currently enrolled in graduate or professional school following earning their degree at UMass Dartmouth.
- 3.4%* of AY 2021 undergraduate alumni were not employed and seeking employment.

EMPLOYMENT OUTCOMES: UNDERGRADUATE ALUMNI

- 79.2% of AY 2021 undergraduate alumni who were employed, were working in Massachusetts.
- 12.8% of those employed were working in another New England state (RI, CT, NH, VT, ME) with another 7.4% working outside New England but in the U.S. or its territories.
- 3.4%* of AY 2021 undergraduate alumni were not employed six months after graduation and were seeking employment. Furthermore, 7.4% were unemployed and were not seeking employment.
 - The most frequently cited occupational groups by AY 2021 undergraduate alumni from the RGS who were employed:
 - I. Healthcare Practitioners and Technical Occupations (14.2%)
 - 2. Business and Financial Operations Occupations (13.9%)
 - 3. Architecture and Engineering Occupations (11.4%)
 - 4. Computer and Mathematical Occupations (8.3%)
 - 5. Education, Training, and Library Occupations (7.6%)

EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES: UNDERGRADUATE ALUMNI

- Of all the AY 2021 undergraduate alumni, 31.6%** were currently enrolled in graduate or professional school following earning their degree at UMassD.
- 14.3% of AY 2021 undergraduate alumni were not employed and currently enrolled in graduate or professional school following earning their degree at UMassD.
- The majority (85.4%) of those engaged in further education were pursuing some type of Master's degree (i.e., MBA, MFA, MS, MA, or other Master's degree). Another 8.5% were pursuing some other type of advanced degree (e.g., Ph.D. or Ed.D., M.D. or D.O., J.D.)
