

2021-2022 RECENT UNDERGRADUATE ALUMNI OUTCOMES AY 2022 NACE Data Collection of Undergraduate Alumni¹

METHODOLOGY

Approximately six months following the completion of their studies, 1,231 undergraduate alumni who had earned their degrees during the 2021-2022 academic year (AY 2022) were asked to participate in the online Recent Graduate Survey (RGS) about their employment and educational activities since graduation.

Overall, 347 undergraduate alumni responded to the RGS (a response rate of 28.2%). In an effort to increase the knowledge rate of our graduating class, additional datamining was completed for those who did not respond to the RGS survey invitations. Efforts from the Career Center and the Office of Institutional Research and Assessment (OIRA) increased the knowledge rate of our graduating class to 69.4% (n=854) by obtaining additional information on 507² undergraduate alumni. This brief details the principal findings from the RGS survey and datamining collection.

Key Findings:

- 94.8%* of AY 2022 undergraduate alumni were employed or enrolled in further education within six months after graduation.
- The full-time employment rate for AY 2022 undergraduate alumni six months post-graduation was 74.2%*.
- 96.8% of undergraduate alumni from the College of Nursing and Health Sciences were employed six months post-graduation with a full-time employment rate of 80.9%*.
- The Charlton College of Business revealed 93.1% of undergraduate alumni were employed six months post-graduation with the College of Arts & Sciences comparable at 93.0% employed six months post-graduation.
- Of all the AY 2022 undergraduate alumni, 30.1%** are currently enrolled in graduate or professional school following earning their degree at UMass Dartmouth.
- The average annual full-time gross salary for the AY 2021 undergraduate alumni working full-time was \$48,360 (median: \$50,000).

EMPLOYMENT OUTCOMES: UNDERGRADUATE ALUMNI

- 80.0% of AY 2022 undergraduate alumni who were employed, were working in Massachusetts.
- 14.3% of those employed were working in another New England state (RI, CT, NH, VT, ME) with another 5.0% working outside New England but in the U.S. or its territories.
- 7.0%/* of AY 2022 undergraduate alumni were not employed six months after graduation and were seeking employment. Furthermore, 4.8% were unemployed and were not seeking employment.
 - The most frequently cited occupational groups by AY 2022 undergraduate alumni from the RGS who were employed:
 - I. Business and Financial Operations Occupations (11.1%)
 - 2. Healthcare Practitioners and Technical Occupations (8.4%)
 - 3. Entertainment, Sports, and Media (incl. Communications) Occupations (7.6%)
 - 4. Computer and Mathematical Occupations (7.5%)
 - 5. Management Occupations (6.7%)

EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES: UNDERGRADUATE ALUMNI

- Of all the AY 2022 undergraduate alumni, 30.1%** were currently enrolled in graduate or professional school following earning their degree at UMassD.
- 56.0% of AY 2022 undergraduate alumni who reported to be not employed were currently enrolled in graduate or professional school following earning their undergraduate degree at UMassD.
- The majority (79.0%) of those engaged in further education were pursuing some type of Master's degree (i.e., MBA, MFA, MS, MA, or other Master's degree). Another 17.6% were pursuing some other type of advanced degree (e.g., Ph.D. or Ed.D., M.D. or D.O.,
