

2018-2019 RECENT UNDERGRADUATE ALUMNI OUTCOMES

AY 2019 NACE Data Collection of Undergraduate Alumni

METHODOLOGY

Approximately six months following the completion of their studies, 1,432 undergraduate alumni who had earned their degrees during the 2018-2019 academic year (AY 2019) were asked to participate in the online Recent Graduate Survey (RGS) about their employment and educational activities since graduation. Overall, 361 undergraduate alumni responded to the RGS (a response rate of 25.2%). In an effort to increase the knowledge rate of our graduating class, additional datamining was completed for those who did not respond to the RGS survey invitations. Efforts from the Career Center and OIRA increased the knowledge rate of our graduating class to 62.2% (n=890) with finding additional information on 529 undergraduate alumni. This brief details the principal findings from the RGS survey and datamining collection.

Key Findings:

- 95.5% of AY 2019 undergraduate alumni were employed six months after graduation.*
- The full-time employment rate for AY 2019 undergraduate alumni six months post-graduation was 77.5%.*
- 99.1% of undergraduate alumni from the College of Nursing and Health Sciences were employed six months post-graduation.
- The College of Engineering had 98.8% of undergraduate alumni employed with the Charlton College of Business nearest with 98.7%.
- Of all the AY 2019 undergraduate alumni, 30.4%** were enrolled in graduate or professional school.
- 4.5% of AY 2019 undergraduate alumni were not employed and seeking employment.
- The average annual full-time gross salary for the AY 2019 undergraduate alumni working full-time was \$48,499 (median: \$49,416).

EMPOYMENT OUTCOMES: UNDERGRADUATE ALUMNI

- 79.0% of those who responded to the AY 2019 RGS who were employed, were working in Massachusetts.
- 14.3% of those employed were working in another New England state (RI, CT, NH, VT, ME) with another 5.9% working outside New England but in the U.S. or its territories.
- 4.5%* of AY 2019 undergraduate alumni were not employed six months after graduation and were seeking employment. Furthermore, 1.1% were unemployed and were not seeking employment.
 - The most frequently cited occupational groups by AY 2019 undergraduate alumni from the RGS who were employed:
 - 1. Healthcare Practitioners and Technical Occupations (16.0%)
 - 2. Business and Financial Operations Occupations (8.9%)
 - 3. Architecture and Engineering Occupations (8.2%)
 - 4. Arts (including Performing Arts) and Design Occupations; Management Occupations (7.1%)
 - 5. Computer and Mathematical Occupations (5.6%)

EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES: UNDERGRADUATE ALUMNI

- Of all the AY 2019 undergraduate alumni, 30.4%** were enrolled in a graduate or professional school following earning their degree at UMassD.
- 8.1% of AY 2019 undergraduate alumni were not employed and seeking further education.
- The majority (85.0%) of those engaged in further education were pursuing some type of Master's degree (i.e., MBA, MFA, MS, MA, or other Master's degree). Another 11.7% were pursuing some other type of advanced degree (e.g., Ph.D. or Ed.D., M.D. or D.O., J.D.) or certificate. An additional 3.3% were pursuing an additional baccalaureate degree
