I. UMassD Scholarships for Study Abroad

Professor Joseph A. Bronstad Scholarship

For students participating in any of the Hessen programs are eligible to apply for this scholarship, which was established to recognize and reward the achievement of a student entering the sophomore or junior year or a first semester senior who will study for an academic year, semester, January intercession or summer program in the State of Hessen, Germany. Preference will be given to students who are maintaining a grade point average of 3.0. Further, preference will be given to students who have successfully completed German 101 and 102.
