The Political Science (PSC) minor consists of 18 total credits in PSC. Six credits are earned in *Foundation Courses* and 12 credits are earned in *Specialized Courses*.

Students must achieve at least a 2.0 grade point average in all Political Science courses and a 2.0 cumulative grade point average.

- A minimum of 1 of these 4 courses must be completed at the PSC 400-level
