The Community Companions program was designed to reduce social isolation for individuals who may be at-risk in our community. Student participants are matched to an agency that serves children, teens, adults, or older adults with various conditions (mental health, cognitive challenges, behavioral challenges, or early memory loss) for engagement in social and recreational activities. Students receive college credit, generally 1 credit per semester, for volunteering at a site for 45 hours per semester (e.g., 3 hours a week for 15 weeks). Additional credits are possible. Attendance at monthly meetings with the program director and reflection assignments are required. Credit is provided as PSY298 and available to non-majors. Sophomore standing and a 2.0 overall GPA is needed. The course is not visible on coin during registration.
