Graduation Requirements:

You must earn passing grades in 90 credits, earn grades of D+ or higher in all required courses (see the listing of required courses below), and maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.3 or higher.

You must take Law 694 Bar Preparation in your final semester.

You must complete the 30-hour Pro Bono Requirement (see [Pro Bono Requirement](#)).

You must complete all MPRE Graduation Requirements (see [MPRE Grad Requirement](#)).

When choosing electives, remember that you must complete the following (see details on the next page):

- Foundation Distribution -- 6 credits
- Practice Distribution -- 6 credits (at least three must be a Clinic or Field Placement course)
- Upper Level Writing Requirement -- 2 credits

Additional Graduation Requirements:

Part-time students with a cumulative GPA below 3.0 after first-year spring must also earn a grade of D+ or higher in:

- 1L Additional Graduation Requirement (taken during second-year fall in place of elective) -- 3 credits
- Law 535 Advanced Legal Analysis (taken during third-year fall) -- 2 credits
- Law 594 Introduction to Bar Preparation (taken during final-year fall) -- 3 credits
