Clinics: Applications will be accepted during the published application dates announced each semester.

Students must follow the process below for applying for a clinical position and return the application forms to the LEC at lec@umassd.edu

1. Complete a Clinical Program Application Form - signed for permission to forward transcript to professor.
2. Complete the unique clinic application and return with the Clinical Program Application Form.
3. You will be contacted when you have been approved and registered.

Student Commitment

Your commitment to the clinic is an indication of the professional responsibility you will be entrusted with in your clinical course. By accepting Clinic enrollment, you agree to waive the ability to drop the clinic during the drop /add period.

Given the demands associated with certifying students for practice in certain clinics and the importance of advance notice needed to schedule appropriate client matters, dropping a clinic should be done only in the event of an unforeseen emergency or under the most extraordinary of circumstances. A letter explaining your reasons for the drop must be submitted to the LEC at LEC@umassd.edu and to the faculty member teaching the course.
