Registration Information

Simulation Practice: Applications will be accepted during the published application dates announced each semester.

Students must complete a Simulation Practice Course Application and return to the LEC at lec@umassd.edu (If interested in more than one, please number them in order of preference.)

Enrollment is based on the following criteria:

Enrollment in Simulation practice courses is subject to the application process publicized during each registration period.

Timely applicants will be prioritized for enrollment as follows:

- students graduating in the current term who need a simulation course to graduate;
- students enrolled in the same program (day or evening) in which the course is offered (for fall or spring terms only);
- students with the earliest graduation term who have not yet taken a simulation course.

If these criteria do not resolve simulation course registration priority, any remaining applicants will be prioritized by lottery.

- Check your email for registration confirmation and/or requests for further information.
- Register for the classes you will take if you do not get into the Simulation Practice.
