The starting time of the exam will not be delayed, nor will the ending time be extended. The actual time you have to do the exam is the same as for others, who are not using laptops for that exam. All exam writers (laptop and paper) will be writing in the same exam room. Ear plugs are available upon request.

Examination Conflicts: A student who has an "examination conflict," as defined in the UMass Law Student Handbook § 16(d) (iii), is entitled to have one of the examinations rescheduled. There is an examination conflict when a student has two or more final examinations scheduled during a 24-hour period, calculated from the start of the first examination. For example, if you have exams scheduled at 1:30 p.m. on Monday and 9:30 a.m. on Tuesday, you have an examination conflict. If you have exams scheduled at 9:30 a.m. on both days, you do not have an examination conflict.

If you have an examination conflict, you must **submit a petition within two weeks of the close of the published add and drop period**. If you do not file a timely petition, you will be deemed to have waived your right to object to the conflict.
