Online Health Insurance

Massachusetts law requires all full-time and three-fourths-time matriculated students to have comprehensive health insurance. These **students will be billed automatically for health insurance.** Students **must then complete an online waiver form** through their COIN account stating whether or not they are requesting the insurance. **This must be done yearly.**

- Applicable Scholarships/Fellowships
- Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan (\$20,500 annual maximum)

Eligibility

General federal student aid eligibility requirements including:

- Enrolled at least half-time (6 credits for Fall or Spring)
- Completed FAFSA for the current academic year

Master Promissory Notes and Entrance Counseling are required for Federal Direct Unsubsidized and Graduate Plus Loans.

Submit completed 2021-2022 UMass Law Financial Aid Application to Law Financial Aid Services. The application can be found in the Forms and Policy section of the Law Financial Aid webpage.
