Examination Conflicts: A student who has an “examination conflict,” as defined in the *UMass Law Student Handbook* § 16(d) (iii), is entitled to have one of the examinations rescheduled. There is an examination conflict when a student has two or more final examinations scheduled to start fewer than sixteen hours apart. For example, if you have exams scheduled at 9:00 a.m. on Monday and again at 4:00 p.m. on Monday, you have an examination conflict. If you have exams scheduled at 4:00 p.m. on Monday and 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, you do not have an examination conflict. The LEC will reach out to students who have previously been granted make-up dates, whether for exam conflicts or any other reason, to let them know whether their make-up dates and times will change or whether they will take the exam on the schedule above.
