M.S. Program Checklist Thesis Option

The M.S. program requires a minimum of **30** credit hours with the thesis option. Students are required to take three core courses (9 credits) and choose additional courses (15 credits minimum) appropriate to a selected area of concentration. Attendance at a weekly seminar series is required (2 credits total, included in the above 15) and each student must present at least one seminar in their third or fourth semester. It is also required that students apply a minimum of 6 credit hours toward thesis research. The student must achieve an overall average of 3.0 in the M.S. degree program. Full-time M.S. students normally complete their degree requirements in four semesters. Part-time M.S. students are encouraged to take two courses per semester.

An average GPA of 3.0 is required in the core courses with B- as the minimum acceptable grade.
