- 1. University of Massachusetts, Dartmouth guarantees acceptance of studentswho are approved by HUSTwith an overall GPA of 2.5, as outlined in this document, and a minimum score of 500/200/72 (PBT/CBT/IBT) on the TOEFL for entrance to any program.
- 2. Transfer students designated above will not be required to take more than 68 additional credits to receive a baccalaureate degree.

Mutual Responsibilities:

- 1. Both institutions agree to maintain current listings of the course equivalencies.
- 2. Hanoi University of Science and Technology and University of Massachusetts, Dartmouth will incorporate a summary of this agreement into official publications and web sites.
- 3. Hanol University of Science and Technology and University of Massachusetts, Dartmouth agree to encourage qualified students to participate in this program by providing information, advising, and other assistance required to foster a seamless transition from the institution.

Review/Revision:

1. Both institutions will periodically review this agreement. Substantive changes in the courses or program of either institution will require a review of this articulation agreement. Revisions will be implemented with one- year notice prior to termination of the agreement.
