# **Articulation Agreement of Academic Programs**

#### between

### Holyoke Community College and University of Massachusetts Dartmouth

#### **Objectives:**

- 1. To attract qualified students to Holyoke Community College and University of Massachusetts Dartmouth.
- 2. To promote and facilitate an efficient transition of transfer students between institutions.
- 3. To provide specific information and guidelines for transfer students.
- 4. To encourage academic coordination and cooperation, including curricular reviews, on-site visits, and joint academic advising for students attending Holyoke Community College.

#### **Stipulations:**

- 1. This agreement applies to transfer students with an Associate of Science in Nursing and Registered Nurse licensure in the state they reside.
- 2. Holyoke Community College graduates may transfer up to 45 nursing portfolio credits upon successful enrollment in UMass Dartmouth's RN-BS online degree program. These credits coupled with the transfer of non-nursing credits from the Holyoke Community College associate degree in nursing, results in a cumulative total of 78 transfer credits applied to the BS in Nursing program at UMass Dartmouth.

### **Mutual Responsibilities:**

- 1. Both institutions agree to maintain current listings of the course equivalencies. This will be the responsibility of the two designated representatives.
- 2. Holyoke Community College and University of Massachusetts Dartmouth will incorporate a summary of this agreement into official publications and web sites.
- 3. Holyoke Community College and University of Massachusetts Dartmouth agree to encourage qualified students to participate in this program by providing information, advising and other assistance required to foster a seamless transition from the two-year institution to the four-year institution.

#### **Review/Revision:**

1. Both institutions will periodically review this agreement. Substantive changes in the courses or program of either institution will require a full review of this articulation agreement. Revisions will be implemented with one year notice prior to termination of the agreement.

Holyoke Community College graduates may transfer up to 45 nursing portfolio credits upon successful enrollment into UMass Dartmouth's RN-to-BS online degree program. These credits along with the 33 non-nursing credits result in a cumulative total of 78 transfer credits toward UMass Dartmouth's BS in Nursing degree.

\*Courses highlighted in blue represent the 31 minimum residency credits to be completed at UMass Dartmouth. The 31 residency credits consist of 28 nursing core credits and 3 non-nursing credits.

<sup>\*\*</sup>If MAT 104 College Alegbra was taken instead of MTH 142 Statistics, it will transfer as an Elective course into UMass Dartmouth providing it was successfully completed. Statistics will remain as a requirement for the RN-to-BS in Nursing program.
