

Objectives:

1. To attract qualified students to Roxbury Community College and University of Massachusetts Dartmouth.
2. To promote and facilitate an efficient transition of transfer students between institutions.
3. To provide specific information and guidelines for transfer students.
4. To encourage academic coordination and cooperation, including curricular reviews, on-site visits, and joint academic advising for students attending Roxbury Community College.

Stipulations:

1. University of Massachusetts Dartmouth guarantees acceptance of Roxbury Community College students who complete the Health Career Program with an overall GPA of 2.5 as outlined in this document.
2. Transfer students designated above will be required to take no more than 69 additional credits to receive a baccalaureate degree.
3. It is understood that students transferring from Roxbury Community College must complete all university studies (general education) requirements to receive the baccalaureate degree.

Mutual Responsibilities:

1. Both institutions agree to maintain current listings of the course equivalencies. This will be the responsibility of the two designated representatives.
2. Roxbury Community College and University of Massachusetts Dartmouth will incorporate a summary of this agreement into official publications and web sites.
3. Roxbury Community College and University of Massachusetts Dartmouth agree to encourage qualified students to participate in this program by providing information, advising and other assistance required to foster a seamless transition from the Roxbury Community College to the four-year institution.

Review/Revision:

1. Both institutions will periodically review this agreement. Substantive changes in the courses or program of either institution will require a review of this articulation agreement. Revisions will be implemented with one year notice prior to termination of the agreement.
