**Objectives:**

1. To attract qualified students to Springfield Technical Community College and University of Massachusetts Dartmouth.
2. To promote and facilitate an efficient transition of transfer students between institutions.
3. To provide specific information and guidelines for transfer students.
4. To encourage academic coordination and cooperation, including curricular reviews, on-site visits, and joint academic advising for students attending Springfield Technical Community College.

**Stipulations:**

1. This agreement applies to transfer students with an Associate in Science in Nursing and Registered Nurse licensure in the state they reside.
2. Springfield Technical Community College graduates may transfer up to 90 credits into UMass Dartmouth's RN to BS in Nursing program. Of the 90 transfer credits, graduates from STCC Associate of Science in Nursing and successful enrollment into UMass Dartmouth's RN-BS in Nursing online degree program will receive 45 nursing portfolio credits and 30 non-nursing credits. Outside of STCC's associate degree, students may transfer, although not required for admissions, an additional 15 credits from an accredited institution to fulfill UMass Dartmouth's non-nursing requirements. These credits must meet the minimum transfer grade point average and fulfill a UMassD degree requirement. See transfer equivalency grid on page 3 for specifics.

**Mutual Responsibilities:**

1. Both institutions agree to maintain current listings of the course equivalencies. This will be the responsibility of the two designated representatives.
2. Springfield Technical Community College and University of Massachusetts Dartmouth will incorporate a summary of this agreement into official publications and web sites.
3. Springfield Technical Community College and University of Massachusetts Dartmouth agree to encourage qualified students to participate in this program by providing information, advising and other assistance required to foster a seamless transition from the two-year institution to the four-year institution.

**Review/Revision:**

1. Both institutions will periodically review this agreement. Substantive changes in the courses or program of either institution will require a full review of this articulation agreement. Revisions will be implemented with one year notice prior to termination of the agreement.

Springfield Technical Community College graduates may transfer up to 45 nursing portfolio credits upon successful enrollment into UMass Dartmouth's RN-BS online degree program. These credits along with the 30 non-nursing credits result in a cumulative total of 75 transfer credits toward UMass Dartmouth's BS in Nursing degree. Students may transfer up to 15 additional credits into UMassD while fulfilling the 31 credit residency requirement.

Courses highlighted in blue represent the 31 minimum residency credits to be completed at UMass Dartmouth. The 31 residency credits consist of 28 nursing core credits and 3 non-nursing credits.
