## REASONS TO PARTICIPATE

- Gain experience presenting your research to general and academic audiences.
- Exchange ideas with other undergraduate scholars.
- Receive feedback from faculty members and peers in your field.
- Enhance your résumé, including your professional online profile.

## ELIGIBILITY

You are eligible to submit an abstract for review if you are an undergraduate student currently enrolled at any of the twenty-eight state universities and colleges within the Massachusetts System of Public Higher Education.

- Students with research projects currently in progress are welcome to submit abstracts.
- All projects must be sponsored by a faculty member.

## PRESENTATION FORMATS

- The Virtual 2022 MassURC requires all students to:
  - 1) submit a pre-recorded, video presentation of research (4-10 min. length)
  - 2) participate in a real-time, virtual, conference day session
- The pre-recorded, video presentation is due prior to the conference day: **Monday, April 11, 2022**
- The 45-minute day-of sessions take place via Zoom through the MassURC event hub and include *Research in Conversation* and *Poster* options.

## NEXT STEPS

1. Reach out to your Campus Contact with questions about the conference or submission process.
2. Secure a faculty sponsor who will provide support for your research project and approve your abstract withing the MassURC system.
3. Register to create a user account. Registration opens **Friday, December 3, 2021**.
4. Write and submit your abstract for review. Abstract submission deadline: **Friday, February 18, 2022**.
5. Your abstract must be reviewed and approved by your Faculty Sponsor in the MassURC system. Abstract approval deadline: **Monday, March 7, 2022**.
6. Record your presentation and submit the URL from your video hosting platform by **Monday, April 11, 2022**.
