Pre-Professional Programs

Fast-track degrees: Arts & Sciences undergrads are eligible to accelerate their graduate degrees through 4+1 Master's in Data Science, 4+1 Master's in Teaching, and 3+3 Juris Doctorate programs.

Pre-Law: Pre-law advisors recommend courses that develop analytical, logical, and creative-thinking skills, providing a solid foundation for any major to pursue future study in law.

Pre-Med and Pre-Health: Work with pre-med/pre-health advisors to pick classes that specifically prepare you for medical school and health professions.

Teaching: Earn professional licensure to teach in MA with flexibility to allow you to earn credit toward licensure in Special Education or English as a Second Language.

RESOURCES FOR STUDENT SUCCESS
